Seattle City Light Work at 8605 35th Avenue Northeast

Dear Seattle City Light Customer:

Seattle City Light is planning activities involving heavy equipment at our property located at **8605 35th Avenue Northeast**. You are receiving this letter because your residence or business is located near the property. This work does **not** involve planned electrical outages.

The former Morningside Substation has been identified for future development as a new park made possible by the 2008 Parks and Green Spaces Levy funds. City Light is cleaning up minor contamination on the property prior to transfer to the Seattle Parks Department.

The planned activities are related to the removal of soils and/or debris from the property. There may be low levels of contaminants such as lead present due to past uses at the site. Any contamination that may be present is contained to the site and will be cleaned up by us.

The work will involve operation of heavy equipment and dump trucks to dig and remove dirt and concrete, etc. Any contaminated materials will then be hauled away for disposal. Standard precautions will be taken to contain the materials and dust, and prevent them from spreading.

The work is planned to occur during the period February 18 through March 8. The actual work should take 10 days. The hours of work are 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Monday - Friday.

Trees currently in contaminated soil must be removed and cannot be replanted, since their root balls would also contain contaminated soils. Replacement trees will be planted.

There may be some disruption to local traffic, parking and sidewalks adjacent to the site; however we will do our best to keep these to a minimum. The work will be completed as quickly as possible to minimize those disruptions. In the event of severe weather or other conditions out of our control, we may need to revise our schedule.
